Tower 49 is an office skyscraper in the Midtown Manhattan district of New York City; it's a 16-sided glass building which sits 45 stories and 614 ft tall above the ground. It was originally built in 1984 and was bought two years later by Kato Kakagu Limited of Japan.

The renovation process included installation of approximately 500 sqm of new floors for which the Caldia marble was used in a honed finishing.
